- *poem*. Memorize section 4 of William Wordsworth’s “We Are Seven.”
- *reading*. Complete Lesson 18 in your study guide and the corresponding reading excerpts from *Retrospect*, a journal-autobiography by James Hudson Taylor.
- *journal*. Write a journal entry on a “bad day” that you had recently.

Long-Term Assignment

- *biography*. You will be writing a 3- to 10-page biography of someone that you know—a relative, neighbor or friend. The only criterion is that the person must be over the age of fifty. Again, here are **sample interviews and biographies** written by past students that you can use as examples. Your outline will be due the last week in February.
- *book report*. Remember that you have a book report due on **the second week of February**. Print out the book report format sheet on the online assignment page and fill it out once you have read your book in its entirety. Suggested book report books are listed on the online assignment sheet if you have not yet chosen one.
