
Classical Greek II Assignment 12

- *vocabulary*. Memorize the vocabulary for Lesson 33 in Davis on page 110, Section 267.
- grammar. Memorize the declensions of πατήρ and άνήρ from the "Dreaded Third Declension" Sheet, and the relative pronoun from the Pronoun sheet posted on the online assignment page. Understand the use of the relative pronoun. (In English the relative pronouns are who, whose, whom, which, that.) The relative pronoun agrees with its antecedent in gender and number. As far as its case, it may take on the case of how it is used in a clause (as is always is the case in English), or the case of its antecedent. Examples follow:



EXAMPLES: ἐπίστευεν ὁ ἄνθρωπος τῷ λόγ φ δν είπεν αὐτῷ δ Ἰησοῦς, the man was believing the word that Jesus spoke to him.

τὰ ἡήματα ἃ έγὼ εἶπον ὑμῖν πνεῦμά ἐστιν καὶ ζωή ἐστιν, the words which I spoke to you are spirit and are life.

μένετε έν αὐτῷ ὅς ἐστιν ὁ σωτήρ τοῦ κόσμου, you are abiding in him who is the Saviour of the world.

μνημονεύετε τοῦ λόγου οδ έγω είπον δμῖν, remember the word that I said to you.
