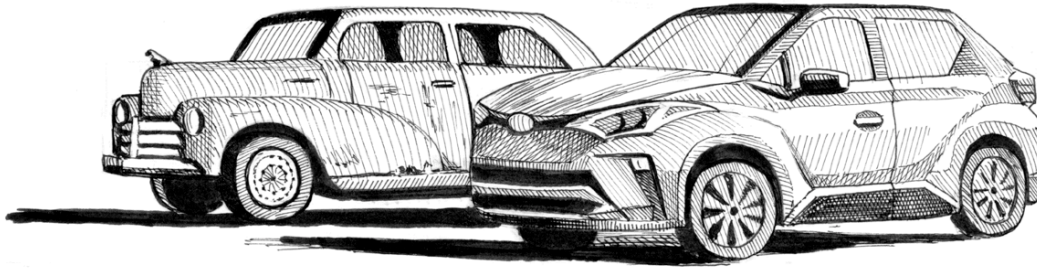


A is for Apple

Reading and Phonics

As I have been doing in class, make sure that your child knows the short vowel sounds and all of the letter combinations for Lessons 1–11 (listed in the appendix). Also, I have provided a handout for students to read for review. As we are a third of the way into the year, I have **chosen sample lessons from a 19th-century primer** for children (also a third of the way into the curriculum) to gauge your child’s progress. Have your child read it and circle any words that he or she stumbles on.

Sight Words

As we have been doing in class, review the sight words. Print out **this sheet**, which contains all of the letter combinations and sight words in simple sentences. Check off the sentences that your child reads perfectly.

Handwriting

Students will not be working in their books again this week; instead, print out **four more handwriting sheets** that I have posted online.

Dictation

Before giving the dictation, review the ow, ending y, ea, ou and th sounds and remind students to capitalize the first word in the sentence and to include an end mark. I will reinforce your work at home by doing dictation sessions in class.
