- A. I. Present. 1. Particular, εἰ τοῦτο πράττει, πάσχει τι, if he is doing this, he is sorry for it.
  - 2. General, ἐάν τις τοῦτο πράττη, πάσχει τι, if anybody (ever) does this, he is (always) sorry.
  - II. Past.
- 3. Particular, εἰ τοῦτο ἔπρᾶξεν, ἔπαθέ τι, if he did this, he was sorry.
- 4. General, εἴ τις τοῦτο πράττοι (πράξειεν), ἔπασχέ τι, if anybody (ever) did this, he was (always) sorry.
- III. Future. 5. Vague, εἰ τοῦτο πράττοι (πράξειε), πάσχοι (πάθοι) τι ἄν, if he should do this, he would be sorry.
  - 6. Vivid, ἐἀν τοῦτο πράττη (πράξη), πείσεται τι, if he do (does) this, he will be sorry.
- B. IV. Unreal. 7. Present, εἰ τοῦτ' ἔπρᾶττεν, ἔπασχέ τι ἄν, if he were (now) doing this, he would be sorry.
  - Past, εἰ τοῦτ' ἔπραξεν, ἔπαθέ τι ἄν, if he had done this, he would have, etc.
