



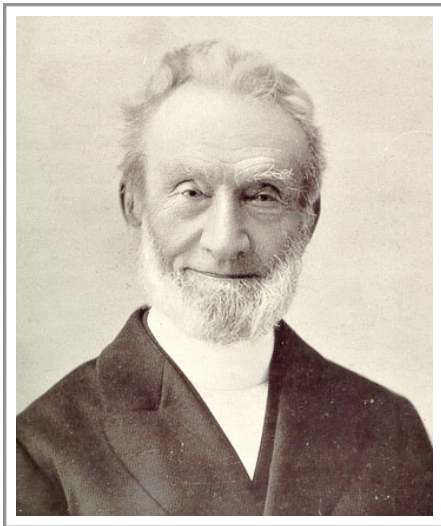

- *reading.* Complete Lesson 17 in your study guide and the corresponding reading of works by John Wesley, Robert Southey and George Müller.
- *literary terms.* hagiography, realistic and idealistic biographies

Long-Term Assignment

- *biography.* You will be writing a 3- to 10-page biography of someone that you know—a relative, neighbor or friend. The only criterion is that the person must be over the age of fifty. Again, here are **sample interviews and biographies** written by past students that you can use as examples. Your outline will be due the last week in February.
- *book report.* Remember that you have a book report due on **the second week of February**.
